



## The Aftermath of Hurricane Florence

The flooding situation after Hurricane Florence is the first of this magnitude experienced by Waccamaw EOC, Inc. Based on the unusual flooding conditions and the length of time centers have been closed, we are approaching the threshold of 80 hours' eligibility for a waiver, allowable for inclement weather payment to staff. This threshold for payment to staff is based on Head Start Federal Regulations. Your Center Supervisor will have a copy of the regulations if you would care to read it.

Because of these circumstances, all Head Start Staff will report to their normal work site, unless otherwise notified tomorrow, September 27, 2018 at your regularly scheduled time. We are attempting to prevent any interruption in your pay cycle. If you are unable to report to work, you must contact your Center Supervisor. As always our top priority is for everyone to be safe but at the same time we must adhere to prevailing federal regulations.
