Waccamaw EOC, Inc. is now accepting names/applications for the 2015 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP). Applications are taken on Monday through Thursday, by appointments only. Please note that Wednesdays are reserved for Elderly and Disabled applicants only. Emergencies will be handled on a case-by-case basis.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant must provide proof of **total household income** for the past thirty (30) days. If you are paid on a weekly basis, you will need your last four check stubs. If you are paid on a bi-weekly basis, you will need your last two check stubs. Anyone receiving Social Security or SSI must provide a current Award Letter or a statement from the Social Security Office indicating the gross amount of benefits. If you receive Unemployment Benefits, you must have a current printout from the Unemployment Office, indicating the weekly benefit amount. Anyone 18 years old or older with no income must also obtain an Unemployment Printout. This indicates no income or no work history.
2. Applicant must have a Social Security Card and also a South Carolina Picture ID (cannot be expired). The address on the ID and Electric/Gas Bill **must match**, if not; you must obtain an ID showing your correct address. A Social Security Card **must** also be provided for all other household members.
3. Applicant must have their most recent Electric Bill. Energy charges must be shown separately from any other charges on the bill (i.e. water, sewer, outside lights). The Electric Bill must be in the applicants name or a member of the household and that person must be 18 years old or older.
4. For Emergency Assistance (must have occurred in the past ninety (90) days), you must have the current Electric Bill and the Disconnect Notice you received after the bill. You cannot have a Disconnect Notice and the Electric Bill after the Notice. You must bring in all documents that justify the Emergency (i.e. if you were Laid Off, you must have Documentation from your Employer showing that you were Laid Off).
5. Anyone applying for assistance must meet the Federal Poverty Income Level Guidelines. You must be income eligible and program eligible to qualify for assistance.
