Summer Food Service News Release

The Waccamaw Economic Opportunity Council, Inc., is participating in the Summer Food Service Program. The Summer Food Service Program is designed to bridge the gap between, when children are in school and when schools are closed, by continuing to provide nutritious meals and snacks to children. Meals will be provided to all children ages 18 and younger without charge.

The Waccamaw Economic Opportunity Council Summer Food Service Program will begin Monday, June 21 – August 6, 2021. Site locations, contact information, opening/closing dates, and meal times are attached.
